Workshop topics include:

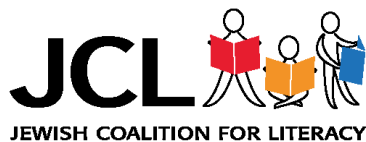
- ENCOURAGING READING YEAR ROUND
